6. Save, but Don't Get Greedy – Proverbs 6:6-8; Matthew 6:19-21
7. Be Honest in All Your Financial Dealings – Proverbs 11:1, 3
8. Pay Your Debts – Psalm 37:21; Proverbs 3:27
9. Don't Get Involved in "Get Rich Quick" Schemes – 1 Timothy 6:9
10. Work to Support Yourself and Your Family – Ephesians 4:28; 2 Thessalonians 3:10
